# What is the PMP Certification

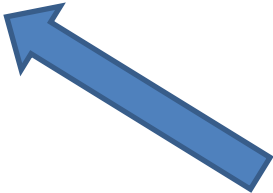
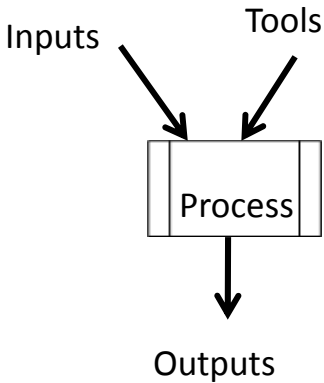
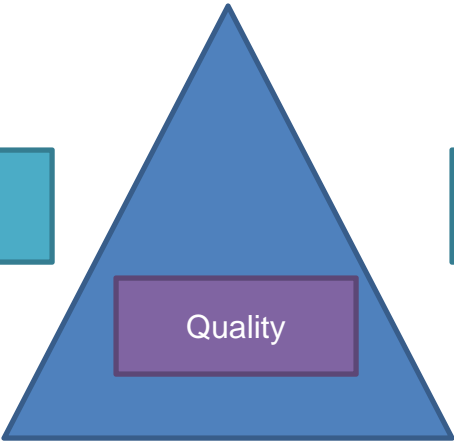
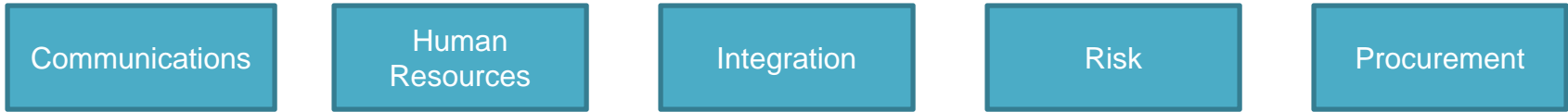
## What is the Project Management Professional (PMP) Certification?

The PMP certificate is the most coveted certification for project managers, executives. Functional managers, system engineers, managers, educators, professionals in the Information Technology, Manufacturing, Service, Quality, Logistics, Aerospace and various Other sectors. It is recognized world wide including countries such as U.S., Europe, Japan, Australia, India, China, Singapore, Malaysia, Dubai, and others. Average salaries of PMPs In the U.S. is over \$95 K and rising. The PMP certificate is issued by PMI a prestigious Organization recognized throughout the world as the ultimate authority in Project Management standards.

- Understanding the PMP Exam Structure
- The PMP exam is a multiple choice 200 question exam with four choices per question. The exam questions are randomly distributed from a database of several thousand questions written by scholars in the field of project management. The distribution of questions by domains (approximately) is as follows:
  - Initiation – 22 questions
  - Planning – 46 questions
  - Execution – 54 questions
  - Monitoring & Control – 42 questions
  - Closing – 18 questions
  - Professional Responsibility / Ethics – 18 questions
